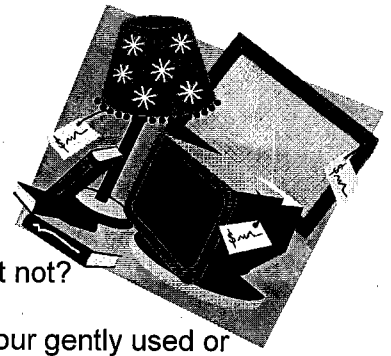
Experience working with children/or teaching would be beneficial. Some training will be provided.

Please tell your family and friends, and please think of CCS whenever you part with any resalable item.

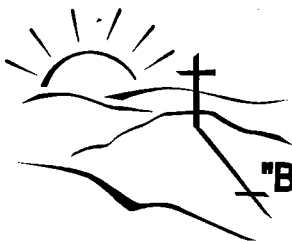
